The Student Satisfaction **Survey** focuses on the overall learning experience of the students. The SSS was conducted as per the standard questionnaire provided by the NAAC Bangalore. The brief observations about the survey are as follows:

- Total 177 responses from total 662 students i.e. 26.73 % responses are obtained from the students of UG level programmes.
- 53.1% male and 46.9 % female and 00 transgender students participated in this Survey.
